## Serving our schools

Alongside our offer of Learn-It! 1-to-1 instrumental teaching across schools in Essex, we are delighted to bring to our school colleagues our provision for the 2023-24 academic year.

All of our provision is inclusive, designed to support you and your school as part of the personal, social, academic and developmental journey of your young people through music.

### Learn-It! - simple administration for schools

Our Direct Parent Billing service means we manage the applications for tuition and payments from parents so you can concentrate on creating a timetable that works for your school.

#### **Discounts**

We continue to offer our highly subsidised tuition discount of up to 66%, and The Virtual School generously funds 15 minutes per week for Looked After Children (LAC) or Post-Looked After Children (PLAC). LAC, PLAC and children who have or have had a social worker can also benefit from additional musical investment from the Virtual School.

### **SEND** support

Our staff are trained in working with students with Special Educational Needs (SEND) on a day-to-day basis, working with the school. We also have a number of specialist staff working in SEND settings and are trained to work with a broad range of students with needs.

## Play-It!

## Develop musicianship by learning to play an instrument as a whole class.

Children learn to play a musical instrument as a class alongside their teacher led by a specialist music tutor from Essex Music Service. They will learn what it means to be a musician, developing understanding and skills needed for musical learning through learning to play an instrument.

Support student progression in KS1-3 and embed instrumental learning through subsequent terms of Play-It! delivery, or delivery in different year groups. You provide the children, we provide the specialist teacher and instruments, if you need them!



## Play-It!

To support schools to embed instrumental learning into their curriculum we are offering the following funding options:

#### **KS2 offer**

1 term of Play-It provision in 1 year group fully subsidised if booked alongside a conversation with a member of your School Leadership Team or the music co-ordinator.

Or 1 free term with all additional terms charged at £342 per class.

### Learn-It!

Individual instrumental learning in 1-to-1, or groups of two or three.

Continuing to learn music through their instrument, we offer high-quality tuition with our experienced staff to support and develop your students' musicianship.

In-school ensembles

Looking to bring your students together in an ensemble? No matter the mix of ability or instruments, we have the staff!

Be it choirs, orchestras, or bands - from beginners to high level we can provide you with an experienced tutor to coach your students in the joy of making music together in your school!

## Learn-It! Together

Small group instrumental learning for beginners in groups of 4 to 6 students.

Learn to play a musical instrument as part of a small group or continue learning following on from Play-It!

Learn-It! Together sessions allow students to develop musicianship and performance skills as part of an ensemble alongside increasing instrumental technique on one instrument.

Music enhances the education of our children by helping them to make connections and broadening the depth with which they think and feel.

## **Curriculum resources**

A suite of online curriculum resources to support all aspects of the music curriculum delivery in school.

We work with our partners to provide training and Continuing Professional Development (CPD) for you to get the best use of the resources in school across the year.

We offer a variety of resources including Charanga Musical School, Sing Up and Sparkyard at Primary level, Charanga Secondary (including VIP Studios), Focus on Sound, and Sing Up at Secondary level, and we work with each SEND setting to find the best fit using these resources.

### Charanga

An online music platform that contains resources for all areas of curriculum and extra-curricular musical activities in primary, secondary and SEND settings. Includes curriculum schemes, resources for singing and instrumental lessons and material especially developed for Essex schools. YuStudio, an online Digital Audio Workspace, is available for KS2-5 with VIP Studios available for KS3-4.

#### **Arts Award**

If you are looking for accreditation for your students in the Arts, we can support you to explore, embed and deliver an Arts Award programme from Discover to Gold level.

#### **Artsmark Awards**

Looking to use the Arts to drive change and progression in your school? We are here to support schools who are embarking on an Artsmark journey and our music tuition, curriculum support and workshop provision can form part of your school's creative development.

#### **Conductive Music**

### Rap-It!

Tailored to your school's needs, Rap-It! introduces students to the world of rap, hip-hop, grime and spoken word. These sessions are a perfect way to develop confidence in students, enhance and link to music and other curricula, especially English and literacy.

We have a programme of CPD delivered alongside our partner organisations. Our senior management team includes practising primary and secondary teachers and we're more than happy to support you.

#### Teach-It!

We can offer PPA and music curriculum cover within your school. We have many outstanding music tutors with years of teaching experience who can deliver music education as part of your team. These specialists can also support other teachers to develop their practice, or simply cover the skills gap that you have within your school.





## Beyond the School Day

### Bringing our young people together

Across our wonderful county we have a network of outof-school venues and options for all our young people, be it orchestral, vocal, rock and pop, music tech and more!

#### **Essex Music Schools**

Across the county our Essex Music Schools bring together children from the area, enabling smoother transition from Year 6 to Year 7, offering a range of 1-to-1, small group and ensemble provision.

### **Junior Programmes**

A mixed programme of group instrumental and vocal sessions at the Mercury in Colchester and in Harlow, this is the perfect follow-on for Play-It! out of school time, or for those wanting to start their musical journey.

### **Community Music Centres**

Running after-school and on Saturdays across the county, with one per district of Essex, our Community Music Centres are hives of group music-making!

#### **Terms and Conditions**

Our terms and conditions are published annually and are held on our website.

Our provision is offered subject to availability of workforce and budget where appropriate.

Our notice periods for ongoing provision are at the half-term holiday of each term to end at that term.

### **Quality assurance**

We run a comprehensive CPD programme for our tutors in order to develop and support them as well as ensuring they can bring their best when working in your setting.

Tutors are also visited annually by a lead tutor for observation and feedback.

### Safeguarding

All music service staff are part of Essex County Council, and as such undergo a minimum requirement of biennial ESCB Level 2 Safeguarding & Child Protection training.

Our tutors are also on the DBS Update Service, and we provide Single Central Record requests for settings as appropriate.
